

COVID-19 Protocol Spring 2022

The <u>Network for Teaching Entrepreneurship (NFTE)</u> considers the health and safety of our students, teachers, staff, volunteers and guests a top priority. To that end, we are working closely with venues, vendor partners and local governments across the country to ensure our regional Youth Entrepreneurship Challenges are as safe as possible.

NFTE is providing this COVID-19 protocol in advance of the events, so attendees can prepare accordingly. We reserve the right to adjust our protocol should federal and local government change their public health regulations, mandates or guidance.

What can you expect at this year's regional challenges?

Vaccination & Identification	 NFTE requires attendees – including guests, competitors, staff and volunteers – to present proof of COVID-19 vaccination along with their government-issued ID. Attendees ages 18 and younger without vaccine verification must be accompanied by an adult who has valid ID and proof of vaccination. "Fully vaccinated" means it has been at least two weeks (14 days) since you completed either the second dose in a two-dose series (e.g., Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca) or a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson (J&J)/Janssen vaccine.
Mask or Facial Covering	Though optional, mask wearing is highly recommended for your safety.
Other Safety Measures	Guest health was a key consideration when planning the food and beverages that will be served.
