



She is a member of Mindshare, Leadership Maryland, and sits on the Board of FITCI, and is currently TEDCO's Managing Director of Entrepreneur & Ecosystem Empowerment (E3).

**Mary Blackford Founder** Market 7

Mary Blackford is the Founder of Market 7, Washington, DC's first Black-owned food hall that features Blackowned food and lifestyle businesses for the purpose of alleviating food and retail deserts in DC.

Mary graduated from Babson College with a BS in Business Management. As a student she also taught entrepreneurship courses to high school students in



Ghana and South Africa. She began her career in the socially responsible finance industry as an Analyst. In 2013, Mary became one of the founding chapter leaders of the DC Chapter of Women Investing for a Sustainable Economy (WISE), a womenled professional group committed to providing resources to women working within the impact investing industry. In the summer of 2017 she launched her most recent venture Market 7. Market 7 has worked with 60 Black-owned businesses in the DC area to create alternative community pop-up markets that include fresh food, lifestyle products, and home essentials in Ward 7 (DC). Market 7 is currently building a new 7,000 sq ft food hall slated to open this year. Market 7 has been highlighted by the DC Mayor Muriel Browser, The Washington Post, Forbes, CNBC, Black Enterprise, The Washingtonian, Essence Magazine, NBC, FOX, and WUSA.

In 2019, Mary created a partnership with Whole Foods Market (Mid-Atlantic) to bring more Black-owned brands to their stores. Mary has also developed training partnerships with Google and the Greater Washington Urban League to provide entrepreneurial training in underserved communities in 2020-2021.

Mary is a proud NFTE alumna from the class of 2006.

**Keith James Managing Partner Coalition Properties Group** 

Bold. Daring. Charismatic. Keith James is the true essence of a go-getter, achieving success decades before his time. Born in Northern Mississippi, Keith spent his youth traveling around the United States playing in AAU basketball tournaments weekend after weekend. This exposure brought Keith the global perspective needed to see that the world is bigger than your back yard. After graduating from high school, Keith



attended Tuskegee University, earning his bachelor's in Business Administration with a focus in Marketing.

# Keynote

**Diana Dibble CEO, Tripod Coaching & Consulting** President & Co-Founder, Design To Delivery, Inc.

Diana Dibble is the CEO of Tripod Coaching & Consulting LLC™, which opened in 2022. It was founded from her passion for business operations, which she has been doing for decades. Tripod provides business operations services and they are experts in Planning for the "What If" Throughout her career Diana has found that revenue generating activities are



usually a business' priority. However, focusing solely on revenue may be killing the company. That's where Tripod comes it. They are really good at what they do, and they make biz ops fun... or at least more fun.

In addition to Tripod, Diana is the President/Co-Founder of Design To Delivery Inc (D2DInc). D2DInc is a government contracting firm founded in 2001. They provide acquisition and program management support services to US federal civilian and defense agencies. D2DInc recently launched the Small Business Superstore as a new line of business to resell products to the federal government.

Throughout her career, Diana has been recognized with local and national industry awards including the Enterprising Women's 2020 Enterprising Women of the Year award, the 2022 NAWBO Woman Business Owner of the Year award as a top 3 finalist, and the NAWBO Greater DC 2023 Entrepreneur of the Year award as a top 3 finalist. She shares her story to bring awareness and hope, and to fundraise for various medical non-profits and clinical trials.
