

The 2019 NFTE Philadelphia Regional Entrepreneurship Challenge 2nd place winner who went on to represent his region at the NFTE National Challenge, Samuel Johnson is now a living example of what the road to becoming a young entrepreneur looks like.



A rising Senior at High Point University, majoring in Sports Management with a minor in Civic Responsibility and Social Innovation, Sam is the Co-founder of "RE-PRESENT CONSULTANTS," which helps rebrand companies to be more attainable, attractive, and accessible to new and existing clientele. They do this with the 3 R's, Revise (logos), Remodel (websites), and Rethink (marketing strategies).

In addition, Sam is the CEO & Founder of Inquest, a recruiting app designed to level the playing field for all athletes, which is currently in the development process. Sam also has a partnership with an apparel brand called "Do More Say Less," where he continues to help build and grow the business & brand to attain the same heights as Nike and Adidas.

Certified as an extraordinary speaker by High Point University, Sam continues to show off his speaking skills as a teacher and motivational speaker for youth. He inspires young people to lead by example and to be the best versions of themselves, and seeks to give back to the community. Sam volunteers for the Burns Hill Neighborhood Association in High Point, NC, where Jerry Mingo is the president. This association provides a community food pantry for families, a community garden, and a yearly youth summit. He has been volunteering for three years and recently raised \$1,000 in 2-weeks for the Association. Sam also hosts and produces a talk show called the Johnson 5, with which he and his four brothers aim to inspire as many young people as possible.

Samuel Johnson continues to prove that it's not about how young you are, but that if you have the knowledge and apply it as an entrepreneur you, too, can succeed.


