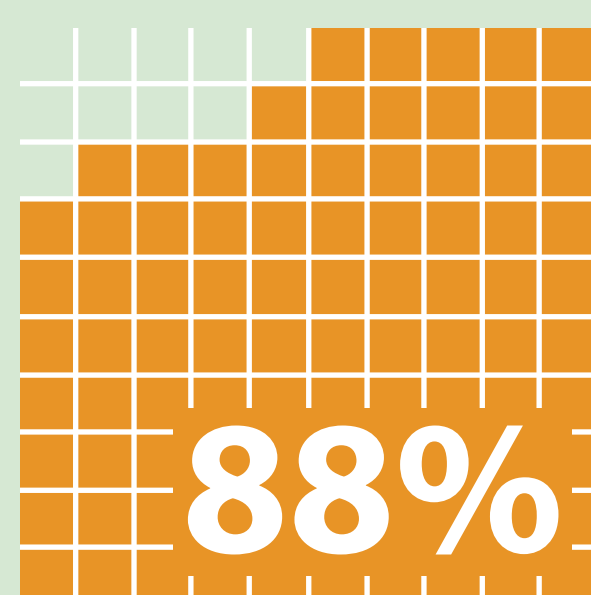

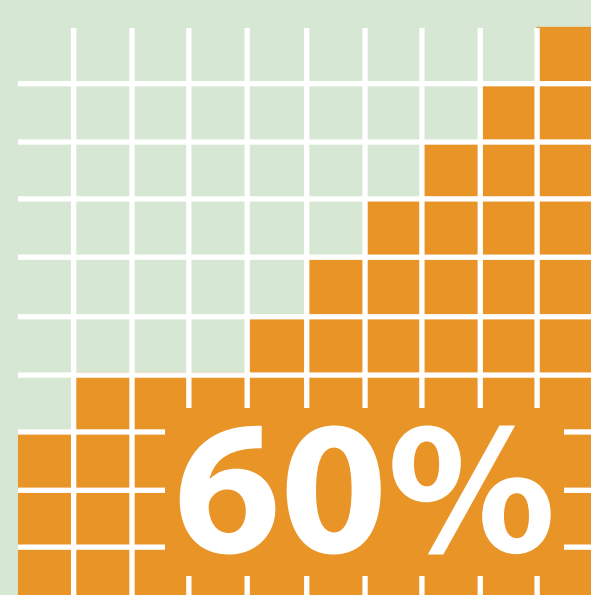

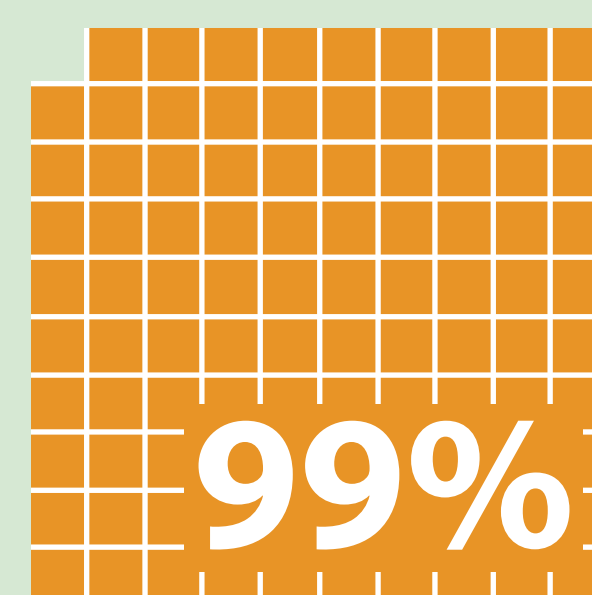

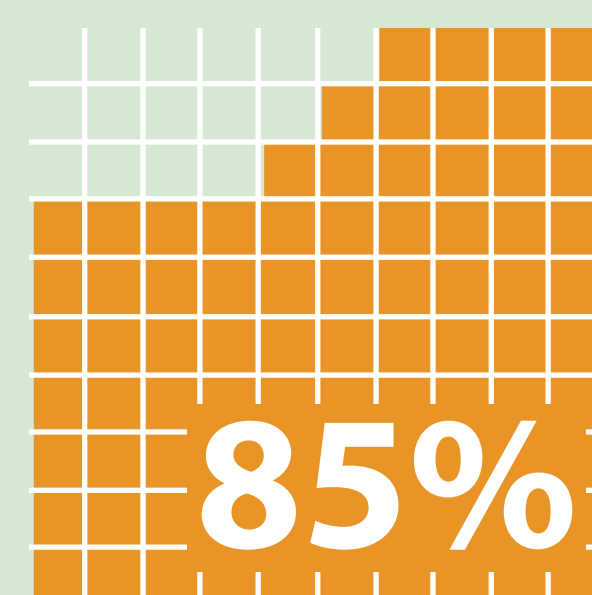


More NFTE alumni earn high school diplomas:

NFTE alumni over age 25



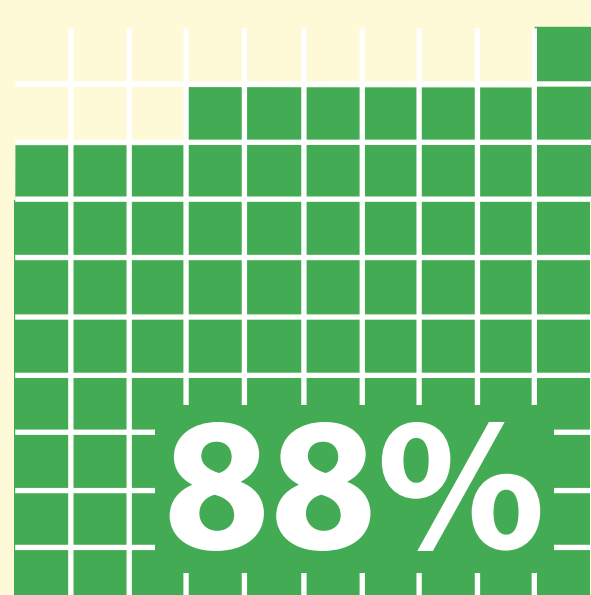
US overall over age 25



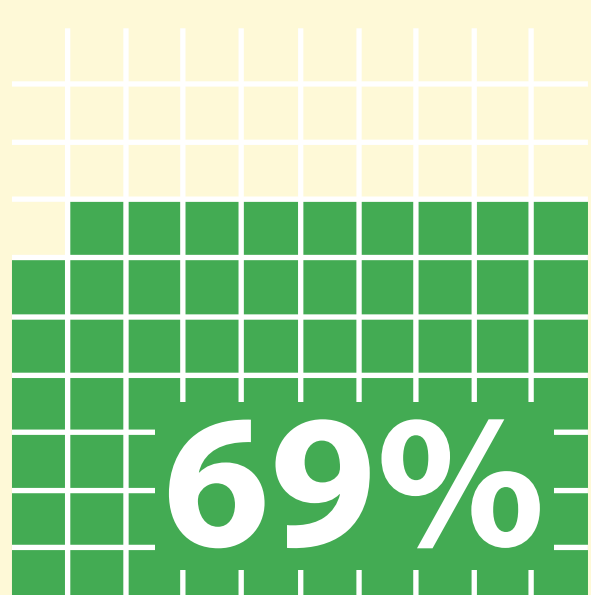

NFTE alumni

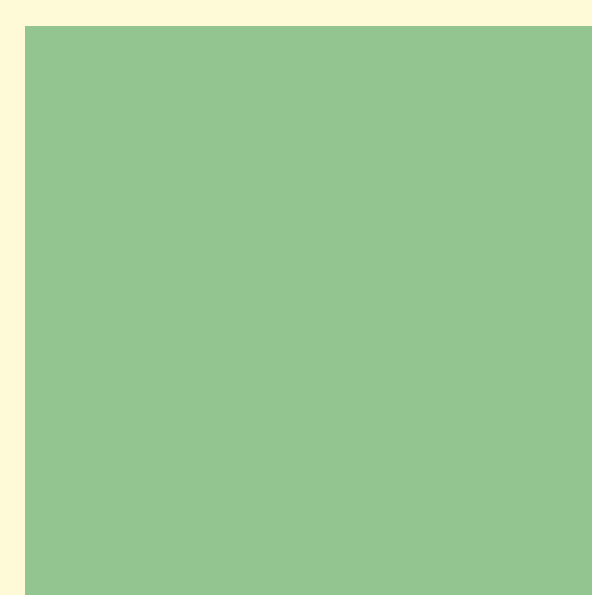
