

NFTE's unique Entrepreneurial Mindset Index© (EMI) measures mastery in 8 core domains that have been identified as critical to entrepreneurs and employers.

- Teachers receive reports that outline student EMI goals
- Based on their top 3 self-reported domains, students create a personalized action plan
